CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

The **SUMMER QUIZ!** is a contest where individuals (in a team of three) compete against other teams.

The **SUMMER QUIZ!** is a unique “answer-and-question” format.

Contestants are presented with clues in the form of answers, and must phrase their responses in the form of a question. Competition points are awarded for correct “answers” to topics of general knowledge.

For example, if the clue is “**British secret agent known as 007**”, the correctly phrased answer should be “**Who is James Bond?**”. If you answered just “James Bond”, that would be incorrect, and points will be deducted.

The **QUIZ 2010** contest will consist of a minimum of 2 rounds of play per game.

Each round of the game consists of five categories. Each category has five questions, with point values ranging from 10 to 50 points. The higher the point values, the more difficult the question will be in their respective categories.

TOP TIP No. 1 : Be quick!

The faster each contestant answers, the more rounds can be played in a game.

This is desirable, because the more rounds played per game, the more points each team can accumulate. The team with the highest points of the entire Quiz becomes the Champion.

TOP TIP No. 2 : Read up before the competition!

One of the categories that will appear somewhere during the Competition is “University of London”. You may research regarding the University of London, and especially on the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE) in their websites. Prepare for this category by clicking on www.londonexternal.ac.uk or www.lse.ac.uk or www.hict.edu.my . You may also want to read up about Economics or Politics, too.

TOP TIP No. 3 : Don't be late!

Come early to the competition, because a briefing of the Quiz will be given before the competition begins. During this briefing, a Mock Quiz round will be played for you to see, and ask questions. The briefing will not wait for late-comers.

Eligibility

1. Contestants must be between the ages of 16-20 as of 1st January 2011.
2. Each team should consist of three players. Each team may include one reserve player.
3. **Completed Registration Forms must be received by the Organiser latest by Wednesday, 28 July 2010. The Registration Fee is RM40.00 per team.**

The registration fee is non-refundable.

4. Each School may enter more than one team.
5. The team with the highest points overall will be declared the Champion, and receive the 1st prize. The team with the next highest points will get the 2nd prize, etc.
6. The use of cell phones or other electronic devices will not be allowed in the Summer Jeopardy! Competition and holding areas. Audience members in the competition room will also be required to turn off all electronic devices, and refrain from helping your teams with any of the answers. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of the entire team.
7. Each contestant is requested to maintain a respectable demeanor throughout the competition. Any disruptions in either the competition room, or the holding room, will result in the immediate elimination of the individual in question from the competition.
8. Points will be deducted for failure to provide the correct answer within the time limit provided. The number of points deducted will be determined by the point value of the question. Points will also be deducted for bonus questions, failing to signal, not waiting to be recognized, failing to answer in the correct format.
9. The information used in this contest is based on data from various sources. While every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of contest information, the HELP International College of Technology (HICT) and the HICT University of London Students' Club cannot guarantee that errors or omissions will not occur. Therefore, neither the College nor the Club can be held responsible for the Summer Jeopardy! Quiz outcomes in the unlikely event such inaccuracies occur.
